Atherton Tablelands Sightseeing for history buffs

Yungaburra

Do the "Old Town Loop" historical walk. Walking map available at most Yungaburra Businesses. Stroll through the Historical Lake Eacham Hotel (Yungaburra Pub), with it's gracious 'olde world' atmosphere.

Malanda

Have a drink in the Historic Malanda Hotel.

The Malanda Dairy Centre has a small historical museum.

The Majestic Theatre is a traditional country picture theatre that has thankfully survived, original oak framed canvas chairs and all. Latest release double features are shown Friday and Saturday night.

Peeramon

The Peeramon Hotel (historic pub) has nice views from the verandah, and interesting bits and pieces inside.

Atherton

Atherton Chinatown Museum, visit the Hou Wang Temple built from rainforest timber and corrugated iron (the only surviving temple of its type), and new interpretive museum.

Atherton has two antique shops, one on either end of the main street of the town.

Tolga

Visit the Railway Museum in Tolga.

5 minutes out of Tolga is the Rocky Creek Memorial. (Plaques dedicated to Army Units of WW11 that were training in the area).

Herberton

Herberton Historical Village has an impressive collection of historical buildings and antiques. Herberton Spy & Camera Museum. Enjoy a personalised tour of unique and rare cameras.

Mareeba

On the highway 5 minutes before Mareeba is Beck's War Museum. Tanks, Planes, trucks, cars, jeeps, relics of wartime.

Mareeba Heritage Museum and Information Centre is just at the entrance of Mareeba.

Irvinebank

Loudon Museum detailing the history of this tin mining town.
