Atherton

On the outskirts of Atherton on the way to Herberton or Ravenshoe turn on to Hastie's Swamp Road, look for the sign to Hasties Swamp which is a large seasonal wetland renowned for its diverse bird populations. More than 190 bird species have been recorded throughout the different aquatic environments in Hasties Swamp. A hide for birdwatching, as well as the nature walk around the southern end of the swamp have recently been built here. Interpretive signage along the track educates walkers on the about Aboriginal and European heritage of the swamp and its bird life.

Mareeba

Mareeba Wetlands is a must do for bird watchers. 6,000 acres of open savanna woodland, including 350 acres of wetlands. Boat tours and canoe hire available, visitor centre, walking tracks. Levy payable for entrance to the park. Open times variable, usually during the dry season only.
